

The IFEX Tunisia Monitoring Group (TMG), formed in June 2004, is a coalition of 14 organisations which monitors Freedom of Expression conditions in Tunisia and focuses attention on the country's need to improve its freedom of expression record - all the more important as Tunisia will host the 2nd phase of the World Summit on the Information Society on 16-18 November 2005. IFEX is the global Freedom of Expression network. It was created in 1992 and has 65 members worldwide.

The TMG has led 3 missions to Tunis since January of this year. The most recent week-long mission took place two weeks ago and witnessed an overall deterioration of rights.

Isn't it ironic that a serious World Summit on the Information Society will be held in a civil society environment of documented systematic repression and lack of freedom of expression, association, press and publishing ?
